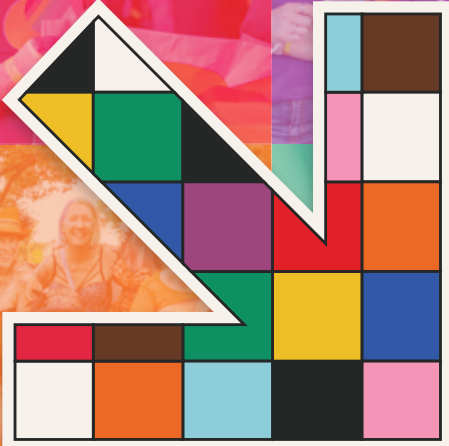

Our theme this year is We Are Here. It asserts visibility and resilience of our LGBTIQ+ community. It's inspired by historic activism, it emphasises that we have always existed and will continue to take up space - unapologetically.

Our theme connects Western Australia to global struggles and recognises both past, and present, fights for equality. We are Here highlights the geographic and cultural diversity of LGBTIQ+ people across WA. It also carries a message of solidarity, reminding those facing isolation that they are supported, while calling on allies and institutions to actively uplift and protect our queer community.

We Are Here also allows all of us to tell our own stories. Our community is so unique and diverse and we really want to see everyone making the theme their own. Whether it be marching in the historic Parade, taking part in our community Fairday or attending one of our many smaller events for our whole community: We Are Here.

Perth, get ready for Pridefest 2025!

Across 10 spectacular days, Pridefest will fill our City of Light with colour, celebration and confetti.

The City of Perth is proud to host all the major events - from Fairday to the brand-new Pride Club Day at Supreme Court Gardens. Northbridge will once again be the beating heart of the festival with Russell Square and venues across the City alive with exciting events, including the iconic Pride Parade and the popular Pridefest Live.

For 27 years, we've proudly supported Pride WA, and we can't wait to come together once again to celebrate Pride in Perth. Happy Pride, everyone!

We Are Here. This year's Pridefest theme is a powerful statement of visibility, unity and resilience, celebrating the rich, diverse and vibrant LGBTIQ+ community that makes Western Australia such a great place to live, work and play.

Western Australians can be proud of the progress we have made together. Earlier this year, important gender recognition reforms came into effect, creating a streamlined process for trans and gender-diverse people to update their sex or gender with dignity and respect. The outdated Gender Reassignment Board has been abolished, bringing WA into line with other States and Territories.

We have also introduced the new Assisted Reproductive Technology and Surrogacy Bill - a once-in-a-generation reform that removes outdated barriers and ensures more Western Australians can start or grow their families. The Bill expands eligibility for altruistic surrogacy to include same-sex couples, single men, transgender and intersex people, and modernises ART regulation to reflect medical advancements and community expectations. These reforms will make the system simpler, safer, and more inclusive for all.

These changes build on Labor Governments strong track record of advancing equality, but I know there is more work to do. We Are Here is a reminder that progress must be actively defended and expanded. My Government is proud to stand with the LGBTIQ+ community on this journey.

Pride would not happen without the hard work of the Pride WA Board, staff and volunteers. Thank you for your efforts. I look forward to joining you at the festivities.

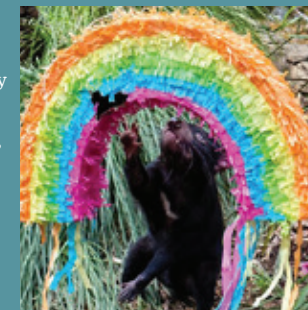
Pride at the Zoo

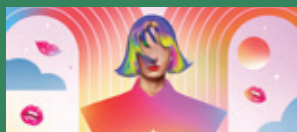

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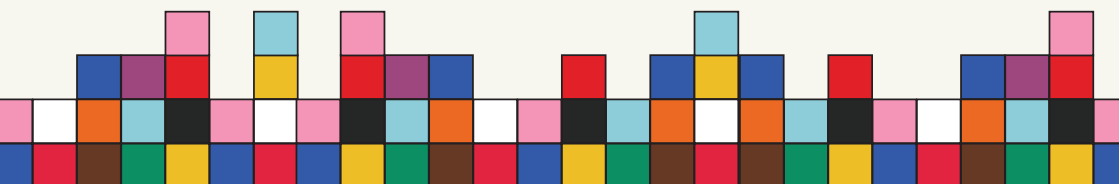
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
